

Unapproved Minutes for the Town of Rocky Ripple Board Meeting, Nov. 10, 2009

The meeting was called to order at 7:30pm. Official business could not be conducted because not enough board members were present.

Robert will be driving the truck in the veterans' parade downtown. He is one of three drivers that are covered by the town insurance at present. He got permission to use the truck by e-mail from Angela and Carla.

The salt spreader is junk. There is salt impacted in the rails and the conveyor, main pump, and gear drive are locked up. We can spread sand by hand this winter. Only intersections will be sanded. The city of Indianapolis has the responsibility to salt the bridges.

We need to find qualified snow plowing volunteers. They will be checked out in a similar manner as the park mowing volunteers. Danny Orr said he would send out an e-mail.

Jon Stohler & Robert repaired the hole on 51st St. between Lester and Clarendon and added drainage. Adam Garvey will donate gravel for further needed repairs, but would like it to be a tax deductible expense. It was suggested that we could work with the Community Association to do that.

No more park mowing is needed this year. Once again, a huge thank you to the volunteers! Also to Danny Orr for coordinating the effort.

Thanks to Jon Stohler for fixing the stop sign at Patterson and 52nd.

Jon Stohler stated that he has not agreed to the proposal for the road vacation for Riverview Dr. presented at the October meeting. He has not had time to fully review the proposal and wants to be sure that he will always have legal access to his house.
